Green Processing Company (GPC) is a Burundian agro-industrial company. It presses avocados into oil at its plant in the Ngagara industrial quarter of Bujumbura and puts all of the residues to use. The plant has been operational since May 2025. It operates the L'Avocat des Barundi brand, the country brand of L'Avocat d'Afrika.
